



GREENE KING OXFORD & DISTRICT AUNT SALLY

LEAGUE Rules 2011

1. The Association to be called the "Oxford and District Aunt Sally Association", and shall be governed by a President, Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary/Treasurer, Assistant Secretary and Committee, a minimum of 8 and a maximum of 12.
2. All monies to be banked in the name of the Treasurer and two Trustees.
3. All elected Committee Members to have a vote with the exception of the Chairman. The Chairman to have casting vote in case of tie.
4. A quorum shall be 50 per cent of Committee members.
5. The Committee shall have the power to fill any vacancy on Committee during the year. Any member missing two consecutive meetings to be asked to resign.
6. A special General Meeting can be called by the Secretary only if a minimum of 25 teams support the application. The Captain of each team to sign the request.
7. All complaints to come from Team Captain within 7 days to be accompanied by £10 returnable if upheld. Appeals Committee to consist of 5 members. No more than 3 to sit.
8. The game shall consist of three Horses, one point each Horse, and played eight a side.
9. The time of starting of all games shall be 8.30 p.m. sharp and, in the event of a full team not being present, the game shall start; absent players may take their throw in the remaining Horses to be played when they arrive.
10. The Captains to toss for first Horse, the Winning Captain has the choice, including three and one stick. The Losing Captain to have choice in the second Horse, including three and one stick. The Captains to toss for third Horse, the Winning Captain to have choice, including three and one stick.
11. Each member of the team shall throw six sticks each, and may throw under or round arm, and both feet must be behind the Hocking by the time the stick has left the player's hand. When three sticks or one stick are necessary, only this number of sticks must be held.
12. It should be clearly understood that the team not throwing should stand away to allow the other team a clear space to throw.
13. The pitch must be 10 yards long from the Doll Standard to throwing point, where there must be a raised Hocking, 1in. high 2ft. 6in. to 6ft. long.
14. The Doll shall be 2ft. 6in. from the ground, and stand on a vertical swivel stand, the swivel to stand out 6in.
15. The Wooden Doll shall be 6ins. high $3\frac{1}{4}$ ins in diameter and painted white. Sticks to measure $18\frac{1}{2}$ ins by 2ins. maximum.
16. All League games to be played on a Wednesday as per fixture list. Games started must be completed.
- 16(a) Games cancelled through inclement weather shall be played within 28 days. Teams not agreeing to play within 28 days will forfeit the points.
17. No League games to be played after the end of the League season.
18. All results of League matches to be sent in by the winning team. Result cards to reach the Asst. Sec. not later than Tuesday following the match. Failure to do so, points won will be forfeited.
19. Sticker-up to be a registered player, and if both Captains agree to sticker-up his decision must be final.
20. Knock-out Competitions which are scheduled should be played on fixed dates unless mutually agreed by both Captains. All players and reserves the original registration form only. Failure to agree the team failing to play on the fixed date will forfeit the game. Results of all K.O. Competitions to be sent in by the winning team to The Secretary only.
21. The Committee is allowed to use its discretion on strength of teams as regards Sections.
22. The names of players must be nominated for each team at the time of entry into the League. A player is allowed to play for one side only. Transfers will be allowed at the Committee's discretion.
23. Anyone found guilty of breaking the rules to gain an unfair advantage, therefore bringing the game into dispute, and anyone resigning from the Committee, will be barred from any office in the O.D.A.S.A. for the following year.
24. All Cups to be returned in good condition, failure to do so, the House or Club to be fined £30. If fine is not paid, further action will be taken by the Committee.
25. In case these rules do not provide for every contingency and questions arising beyond them, same shall be decided by the Committee only, who, if necessary, will hold a Special General Meeting to discuss same.
26. Any Team failing to fulfill two consecutive weeks fixtures will be expelled from the League.
27. Any engraving on Knock-Out and Section Cups must be done through the Association and paid for by the teams concerned.
28. Propositions for alterations to rules must be in the hands of the Secretary 14 days before the Annual General Meeting. Only amendment or new rules excepted with proposer and seconder attending A.G.M.
